#### Anti-roll bar kits 22 & 25mm

Our latest anti-roll bar kits have been tested for more than a seasons full racing with great success.

We now offer these as kits including all brackets, fixings, bushes etc needed to fit to your Healey.

Using the original geometry they work as intended and are 25% (1.4kg) lighter than our competitors. Note that this is partly unsprung weight located at the very front of the car.

As we do not compromise on quality the uniballs we have chosen are the <u>highest motorsport quality.</u>

The bar itself is made from spring steel and heat treated with two different methods for long lasting and maximum strength compared to weight and diameter.

After this they are shot blasted and powder coated.

The link between the uniballs are left and right threaded for easy adjustment on the car and to remove any preload that is so common in non adjustable solutions.
