Qualifying went well and weather conditions with clouds and 12-14°C saw the Healey in pole by 0.5 second. "A comfortable margin considering the lap is only 1,7km" commented driver Anders after the session.

Race 1

Starting from pole the red and silver Healey got well off the line and pulled a big gap to second placed Lotus Elan already on lap 1. Further back the field another Lotus crashed into the armco along the straight and safety car was deployed for 4 laps. After the re-start Anders outpaced his opponents and won the race by 12.6 seconds. The Lotus Elan and a Marcos 1800GT finished in 2nd and 3rd.
